ISSUE

Requirement: Additional Patriot fire unit resourcing to remain a ready force, preserve strategic flexibility and accomplish 1:2 Deployment:Dwell ratio.

How It Fixes the Shortfall: Resourcing additional Patriot fire units in TAA 19-23 addresses the following:

- supports COCOM demand
- provides a dedicated Global Response Force (GRF)
- supports AIAMD modernization efforts
- preserves the health of the force

Additional capacity is necessary to address COCOM demand, readiness and build future capability to keep pace with growing threats.
