# 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) Mission Statement



**OCONUS:** On order, the 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) will provide sustainment capability to Army, Joint and Multi-National forces as well as interagency elements engaged in military operations including support of combatant command requirements.

**CONUS:** The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) provides Mission Command to trained and ready forces supporting worldwide contingency operations and provides support during national emergencies as directed by the National Command Element.

**Fort Hood Mobilization Mission Statement:** The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) provides Mission Command of assigned, attached and operationally controlled units in support of III Corps. The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) plans and executes logistical operations on Fort Hood, Texas. The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) serves as III Corps' senior logistics command with coordinating authority to Sustainment Brigades within the area of responsibility. The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) prepares and trains sustainment units for deployment as well as improves installation sustainment operations through mutual support arrangements, exchanges of information, and best practices.

## Key Tasks:

- Provide Mission Command of subordinate logistics units.
- Plan and execute sustainment operations on Fort Hood, Texas.
- Maintain oversight of sustainment operations within III Corps with direct coordination with the division G-4s and Sustainment Brigades.
- Teach, coach, train, mentor and develop Sustainment Brigades

### Definition

### Objectives

Ensuring a flexible headquarters capable of conducting mission command and execute orders with minimal risk, while allowing for continuity of support

### End State

310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) provides a flexible sustainment support structure with the ability to assume mission command of other organizations as required ISO III Corps requests, using mission orders to ensure disciplined initiative within the commander's intent to sustain unified land operations

Providing sustainment to allow for continued operations through simultaneous offensive, defensive, and stability operations

### Sustaining Unified Land Operations (ULO)

- Supporting decisive action
- Supporting sustainment operations
- Sustainment distribution
- Providing uninterrupted sustainment
- Leveraging operational reach

#### Key Tasks

- Plan for reception, distribution, control, and flow of resources
- Plan for force projection and sustainment

Providing critical and essential enablers that allow forces to deploy long distance, conduct operations across the depth and breadth of the operational area, and maintain operations for extended duration

Providing opportunity for strategic and operational training of sustainment professionals

### Sustainment Leader Development

- Training for sustainment professionals
- Operational development, self development, and resiliency
- Sustainment leader development
- Staff Assistance Visits (SAVs)

#### Key Tasks

- Professional education and career management
- Synchronize sustainment assets and functions
- Integrate Army programs
- Increase proficiency in Army Warrior Tasks

Developing sustainers who are capable of integrating the learning initiatives and transforming into comprehensive logistics leaders

Establishing a culture of supply discipline and property accountability through accounting for all supplies, materials, and equipment as well as reintegrating excess equipment into the supply system to enhance overall unit readiness across III Corps

### Campaign on Property Accountability/Fleet Readiness

- Training, teaching, and mentoring leaders in the Command Supply Discipline Program (CDSP)
- Equipping the force
- Improving budget management
- Executing campaign on property accountability

#### Key Tasks

- Maintain training readiness
- Execute clean sweep tasks
- Train, teach, and mentor administrative skills sets for leaders

# Highlights



- III Corps and 13th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) submitted a Request For Forces in April 2014 for 126 Personnel to backfill the Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) during their mobilization to Kuwait and the 4th Sustainment Brigade's mobilization to Iraq.
- 310th received a Request For Forces from FORSCOM in December 2014 for 23 Soldiers to deploy forward in February in support of Operation Inherent Resolve as an Advise and Assist (A&A) logistics team to the Iraqi Army.
- Plans and hosts quarterly Leader Professional events for all logisticians on post and executes monthly Logistics Readiness Reviews and Corps Sustainment Reviews in coordination with III Corps G4.
- The 310th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) has been aggressively engaged in III Corps' Fleet Readiness Campaign, increasing operational readiness across the command.
- Provided a 13-Soldier Observer Controller Trainer team for 1st Armored Division's Iron Focus Exercise on Fort Bliss, Texas to mentor the 15th Sustainment Brigade in preparation for their upcoming deployment. The team covered specific training and guidance on mission command, fuel distribution, field maintenance and oversight, field feeding, finance operations, administrative support, and mortuary affairs/casualty operations.
- Provided a 26-Soldier mayor cell for War Fighter Exercise 15-3 and 15-5 on Fort Hood and provided Observer Controller/Trainer support for Iron Focus 15 at Fort Bliss. The 310th will also be providing similar support this month for the 4th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary) Culminating Training Exercise on North Fort Hood.
