Vision

To be the Combat Support Hospital of choice to support Combatant Commanders and missions worldwide.



396 CSH Capabilities Summary



396 CSH: Provide hospitalization and out patient services for all classes of patients to include surgical intervention and post operative care to Soldiers in AOR. Provide Mission Command for assigned and attached medical task organization.

Role I – III Medical Care:

- Scalable and tailorable up to 248 Bed Combat Support Hospital (CSH)
- Early Entry Hospitalization Element (EEHE) consisting of 44 beds can provide Role III care to 32 patients



Head & Neck Surgical

Detachment: provide ear, nose and throat surgery, neurosurgery and eye surgery augmentation in support of theater hospitals



Ground FST: surgical capability within 90 minutes of exiting aircraft and can operate independently for 24 hours



Dental Services: provide Soldier-focused dental services, field dental clinic, operational dental care in a timely manner to supported units



Combat and Operational Stress Control: provides preventive consultation and stress education support to leaders, chaplains, and medical personnel and assists with Mild Traumatic Brain Injury (MTBI)


