

Counter-IED Integration Cell (CI2C) MISSION

Lead, coordinate, integrate and synchronize Counter-Improvised Explosive Device (CIED) and Asymmetric Warfare (AW) training in order to assist units in preparation for deployment. CI2C provides realistic C-IED/AW training in live and virtual environments (VBS3) to support full spectrum operations.

CI2C Capabilities:

Coordinate specialized C-IED instruction and training in Electronic Warfare (EW), Biometrics, Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD), Route Clearance, Homemade Explosives (HME), Virtual Training and Site Exploitation (SE). Provides training in support of the Regionally Aligned Forces (RAF) training requirements.

Provide expertise to develop a holistic C-IED training program that integrates, plans, synchronizes, coordinates, and facilitates all live, virtual, constructive, and gaming C-IED assets into Home Station Training.

Maintain currency on friendly and enemy Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (TTPs) and assist units' incorporation of TTPs into live collective training.



Training Opportunities


Classroom / Field TNG
