National Commission on the Future of the Army to Appear before Congressional Defense Committees

The House Armed Services Committee Subcommittee on Tactical Air and Land Forces (HASC-TAL) and the Senate Armed Services Committee (SASC) will both be holding hearings this week on the National Commission on the Future of the Army's (NCFA) final report.

The HASC-TAL hearing will be Wednesday, Feb. 10 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 2118 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The subcommittee is chaired by Rep. Mike Turner of Ohio. The NCFA witnesses will be Chairman Gen. (Ret.) Carter Ham and Commissioner Mr. Robert Hale – both of whom were appointed to the commission by the Chair and Ranking Member of the full HASC, Mr. Mac Thornberry and Mr. Adam Smith respectively.

The SASC hearing will take place Thursday, Feb. 11 at 9:30 a.m. in Room 228 of the Russell Senate Office Building. The committee is chaired by Sen. John McCain of Arizona. The NCFA witnesses will be Chairman Gen. (Ret.) Carter Ham, Vice Chairman Mr. Thomas Lamont, Commissioner Gen. (Ret.) J.D. Thurman, and Commissioner Sgt. Maj. of the Army (Ret.) Raymond Chandler. Commissioners Thurman and Chandler were appointed to the Commission by the Chair and Ranking Member of the SASC, Sen. McCain and Sen. Jack Reed (R.I.) respectively.
