

- USAR Use down 15% from peak in FY 11 but...
- Joint/Multi Compo Use is **up 427%** from FY 11
- Joint/Multi Compo **is 48% of FY 15** Usage  
Partly due to 91<sup>st</sup> Div CSTX in Feb 15  
(A/C Stryker BDE and CANG Mech BN)
- USMC: 1<sup>st</sup> Div FTXs in Dec 15 & Force Recon in Jan 15
- Navy SeaBees & Special Ops Increasing

### Fort Hunter Liggett

- **160,000 (+) Acres . 7<sup>th</sup> Largest Army Installation** in CONUS (> Bragg or Hood).
- **Remote, Lack of Encroachment** Rivers, Mountains, Valleys Plains.
- **One of Only Two Mediterranean Analogs** in DoD Inventory.
- **5 Mile Convoy Live Fire.** 7 Objectives, 360° Fire, Moving Targets.
- **C-17 / C-30** Landing Strip. Paved Operations 50 Miles away.
- 36 Pad Heliport, 33 Drop Zones, Restricted airspace to 24,000'.
- **Strategic Partnership with Camp Roberts (CANG).**
- **Federally-Owned** Tank Trail to Rail Yard at Camp Roberts (25 Miles).
- **10 station IED Defeat Lane** (Joins W/Convoy Live Fire).
- **No Explosive Impact Area** Enables Surface Maneuver and Tailored LFX.
- State of the Art Weapons Qualifications Ranges (Pistol to Tank Qualification)
- 4 Tactical Base Camps; 1500 Soldiers Each, Austere to Robust Support
- 4 Urban Training Sites.
- 1,740-Bed Training Barracks (864 More Under Construction)



## Unique Training Support Capabilities

### Training Support Facilities

- **5 mile Convoy Live Fire Range (7 Objectives, 360° Live Fire)**
- 6 mile, 10 station IED Defeat Lane. Joint IED Defeat Office (JIEDO) Product Joins with Convoy LFX for Extended Convoy Training Through Urban Environments



- **No Explosive Impact Area (UXO Dud Area)**
  - Enables Unrestricted Surface Maneuver
  - **Tailorable LFXs to Support Any Requirement**
- 4 Tactical Base Camps.
- Each Supports 1500 Soldiers.
- Austere to Robust Support
- 4 Urban Training Sites (MOUT Sites)

## Unique Training Support Capabilities Fort Hunter Liggett

### Air Operations

- **C-17 Assault Landing Strip**, 36 Pad Heliport, **33 Drop Zones** for Airborne Operations
- Restricted Airspace to 24,000. Paved C-17 & C-130 Operations at Paso Robles (50 miles away)



### Lines of Communication (LOCs)

- Civil & Military Air & Sea Ports of Debarkation at Distances Comparable to Theater Ops
- Tactical, Tank Trail to Facilities at Camp Roberts
  - Federally Owned Right of way “Easement in Perpetuity”
  - Supports Tactical Convoy Operations up to 30 miles long (17 Miles FHL to Camp Roberts)


