Joint Reception, Staging and Onward Integration (JRSOI)

WHAT IT IS

Joint Reception, Staging and Onward Integration (JRSOI) is the essential process that transitions deploying forces, consisting of personnel, equipment, and materiel arriving in theater, into forces capable of meeting the combatant commander's operational requirements. Adjutant Generals are ultimately responsible for JRSOI within their respective state.

Reception operations include all those functions required to receive and clear personnel, equipment and material through the point of distribution.

Staging assembles, temporarily holds and organizes arriving personnel, equipment and material into forces and capabilities and prepares them for onward movement, tactical operations or service reintegration.

Onward movement is the process of moving forces, capabilities and accompanying material from reception facilities, marshalling areas and SAs to tactical assembly areas and/or OAs or onward from the point of distribution or other reception areas to the home/demobilization station.

Integration is the synchronized transfer of capabilities into an operational commander's force prior to mission execution or back to the component/service.

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT

JRSOI is the primary means to achieve and maintain command and control of units deployed across the state. JRSOI provides a critical link between deployment and employment into a joint operations area. Successful execution involves planning, training, continuous coordination and teamwork. The movement of National Guard forces across state lines increases the need to plan for and properly execute JRSOI to achieve safety and maintain accountability.

VIGILANT GUARD 2015 JRSOI LOCATIONS

For Vigilant Guard 2015, the Minnesota National Guard's 347th Regional Support Group is tasked with supporting JRSOI operations at three fixed and four mobile sites throughout the state for military members in State Active Duty, Title 32 and Title 10 status.
