**Meeting Summary**

Commissioners Lamont and Chandler, along with The Adjutants General for the State of Hawaii and Guam, met with David Ige, Governor, State of Hawaii, to inform him of the purpose of the National Commission on the Future of the Army and to hear the Governor's view on the Commission's charter and the Army's mission in the State.

The Governor expressed his complete support of the Military and its long history and importance in the State. He further emphasized the strong relationship between the Army and the people of Hawaii and underscored the Army Guard's crucial roles in homeland security and civil relief.

The Commissioners indicated they were seeking input from as many of the States as possible and assured the Governor that this visit with him was an open invitation for continued dialogue.

The meeting closed with the Governor thanking the Commissioners for taking on their important effort, their offer for further discourse, and meeting with him and The Adjutant General.
