

Fort Indiantown Gap NCFA Visit Highlights



- General: NCFA Chairman, staffers, and visitors will interact with the PA Adjutant General, Commanding General 28th ID, and possibly other TAGs and CGs from bordering Guard States. Some BN and BDE Commanders may be available based on scheduling (mostly M-Day Commanders to coordinate).
- Windshield tour of Fort Indiantown Gap highlighting DSCA training site (Rubble Pile), Mission Command Training Center (MCTC) and simulations, Medical Battalion Training Site (MBTS), 166th Regional Training Institute (RTI), and other tenants of Fort Indiantown Gap (US Army Reserves).
- UAV facility: Will allow Commission to see UAV training, witness flight training, and talk/interact with UAV mechanics and operators.
- Unit Training Equipment Site (UTES): Commission will get to see over 649 vehicles maintained and utilized from this site. Commission will get to interact with supervisors and mechanics. Some of the equipment at this site is: All 10 variants of the Stryker vehicle, M1A1, M2 BFV, M777 Artillery, M109 Paladin, just to name a few.
- Eastern ARNG Aviation Training Site (EAATS): Commission will get to observe training and talk to students (multi-compo students). Instructors will show facility and simulation devices.
- Army Aviation Support Facility (AASF #1)/Muir AAF: Commission will see the maintenance, operations, and flight planning. Able to see AH-64D, CH-47D and F, UH-60A/L, and UH-72. Commission will talk to supervisors, mechanics, and crewmembers.
- In General, Commanders and lead Directorates have been directed to be present during this visit as schedule and OPTEMPO allows.
