

High Risk Entry Facility

Our multipurpose High-Risk Entry Facility (HREF) provides residential, apartment and office scenarios with indoor and outdoor entries and stairwells. Each scenario is equipped for various configuration options that provide for additional training situations. The facility is completely wired for light and sound and video recording so training can be reviewed and critiqued.



The indoor engagement skills trainer provides students with interactive video scenarios that provide instant feedback without the costly expenditure of ammunition. The HREF is equipped with the Professional Range Instruction Simulator (PRISim) for law enforcement.

The Northeast Counterdrug Training Center (NCTC) at Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania was established in October 1998. In 2001, a second campus opened at Volk Air National Guard Base in Camp Douglas, Wisconsin. Our charter is to provide no-cost counterdrug training and education to law enforcement and drug demand reduction specialists across the 18 northeastern United States from Maine to Virginia and west to Wisconsin in order to better protect our country and our children from the scourge of drugs in America.



The NCTC is staffed by National Guard Specialists and state employees, who provide infrastructure management. This military and civilian partnership is the cornerstone of the NCTC success story.

The NCTC is congressionally funded through the Department of Defense and is managed by the Pennsylvania National Guard Counterdrug Program.

The Northeast Counterdrug Training Center provides all necessary facilities, instruction and support to enhance the capabilities to reduce and remove illegal drugs from our streets, and educate our communities in the most up-to-date prevention techniques.
