




- 2 JUN: ADVON departs TX for WY with rolling stock and equipment via MIL & COM line haul
- 5 JUN: Units muster at respective locations in TX, AK and RI and prep for departure
- 6 JUN: Units depart respective departure airfields (DAFs) in TX, AK and RI for intermediate staging base (ISB) in SD via USAF assets (NG + AD)
- 6 JUN: BN TF with over 500 paratroops converges on single ISB (Ellsworth AFB, SD)
- 7 JUN: JROSI, ROC drill and mission prep for Joint Forcible Entry (JFE)
- 8 JUN: BN TF departs ISB via 5 x C-130s + 2 x C-17s
- 8 JUN: BN TF conducts INFIL mass-tactical, combat equipped (MT/CE) parachute assault on John Edmunds Drop Zone (JEDZ), WY
- 8 JUN: INFIL complete, BN conducts 7km tactical foot movement into AO




1. 6 JUN: BN TF 500 paratroops converges on single ISB (Ellsworth AFB, SD)
